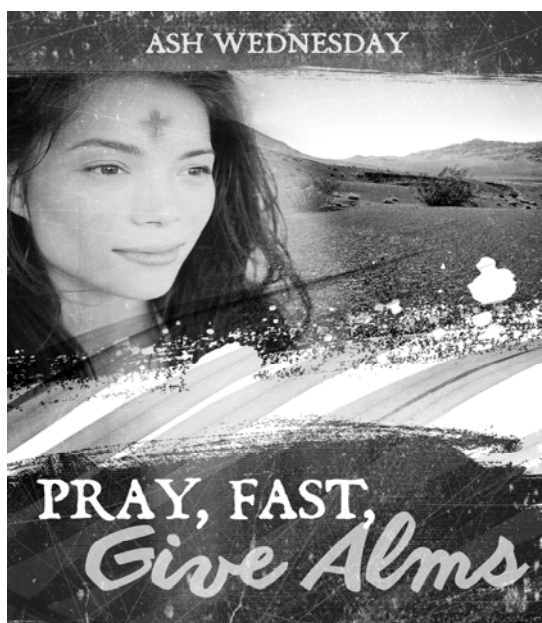

Lenten Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on **Ash Wednesday**, **Good Friday**, and all **Fridays** of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** by all Catholics over the age of 18 but not yet 59. Those bound by this may only take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

With the opening of the Holy Door at the Basilica of John Lateran in Rome, Pope Francis declared that the time for tenderness, joy, and forgiveness had begun.

As Holy Doors were opened around the world at city cathedrals, major churches, and sanctuaries, Pope Francis said that this simple gesture of opening God's house to the world serves as "an invitation to joy." It is the Jubilee of Mercy. Jesus said, "I Am the door," (Jn. 10:7) The opening of the Holy Door is also symbolic of the door of our hearts. The Holy Year is an opportunity for us to enter into the embrace of our God and experience His great love which consoles, pardons, and fills us with hope. It is a time to experience the healing love of God through the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It is a time of special grace and blessings from our God.

As Lent approaches, let us enter into this Holy Season with open hearts ready to receive and to share the awesome gift of God's mercy. The time to heal, help, and to forgive is now.

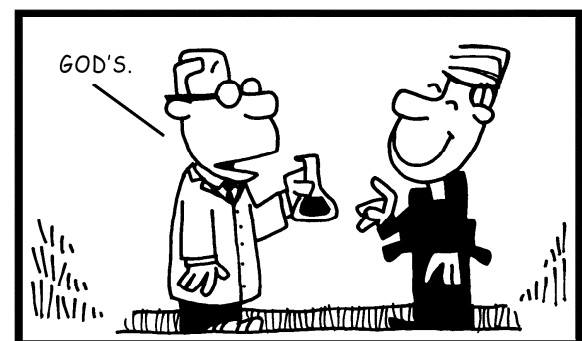

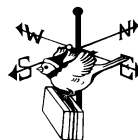
