**Mission Appeals for the Diocese of Butare – Rwanda,
July 23-24, 2016.**

This weekend, we welcome Fr. Joseph Kayongo, who will be with us to speak about the needs in Rwanda.

Please note: Our second collection this week, will support this appeal. All monies collected from our Specialty Envelopes, for those on the envelope system, along with any loose cash collected this weekend will support the work in Rwanda. The Second Collection on July 30/31 (usually our Specialty Collection) will go towards the parish debt.

Rwanda is a small country situated in the heart of Africa that in 1994 experienced a horrific genocide that was politically motivated during which one million people were murdered in approximately 100 days. The genocide left behind many broken hearted like orphans, widows, traumatized..., and many destroyed infrastructures like schools, medical centers, even churches. This tragedy also destroyed the economy of the country and regressed the development of the poor struggling country. Thanks be to God, now there is security in the country. The challenge is to rebuild the nation and to help people to recover from genocide.

Pastorally, in the years since the genocide, the Diocese of Butare has focused its outreach on the youth who are the future of Rwanda, impressing upon them the themes of unconditional love, peace and reconciliation so that the country may heal and experience a brighter tomorrow. The diocese accomplishes this mission through Catholic education which plays a great role not only in teaching the youth sciences but also in teaching them Catholic faith in order to help them to form their moral conscience based on Christian values. This effort has made a great difference and has contributed tremendously to the building of a new Rwanda we see today. Rwanda is a Christian country; 60% of the country's population is Catholic.

The diocese has limited resources this is why we seek some help from you our brothers and sisters in Christ so that we may be able to build more Catholic schools and carry on these projects and continue our mission of making the love of Christ known and felt among the people of Rwanda. As the parable of the friend who knocks at midnight in the Gospel of the seventeenth Sunday teaches us to trust and to be persistence in prayer, so, the friends who are knocking today are the people of Rwanda who come to you today in the middle of the night of pain, suffering and poverty. They come to you today inspired by these words of Jesus, "ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened. They are asking you today to open the door of your generous heart to support them in their struggle to build a better future. Your sacrifice will alleviate their pain and suffering, and will contribute greatly in the mission of Christ of making His love present and felt in the lives of the people of Rwanda.

Thank you so much for your sacrifice. We thank your bishop Most Reverend Robert McManus and your Pastor Rev. Daniel Mulcahy for inviting us to come and share our story and seek help directly from you.

May God bless your families abundantly.

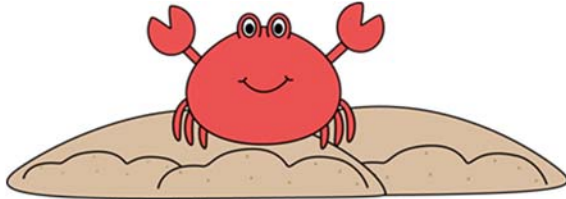

Local Diocesan Programming is now on Charter Channel 193; Boston's Catholic TV is on Channel 101, and EWTN is on Channel 18.

How about making a Cursillo weekend?

Cursillo or "short course in Christianity" is an uplifting and educational experience. Cursillo was brought from Spain to the United States in 1962.
