
The Angelus

The Angelus is a devotional prayer commemorating the Incarnation. It is practiced by reciting, as verse and response, three Scripture verses narrating the mystery of the Incarnation and alternating with the Hail Mary.

Traditionally, this devotion was recited in churches, convents, and monasteries three times daily, at 6:00 AM, noon, and 6:00 PM. The Angelus is usually accompanied by the ringing of the Angelus bell which is a call to prayer and to spread good-will to everyone. The angel referred to in the prayer is Gabriel, a messenger of God, who revealed to Mary that she was to be the Mother of God.

During this month of May, the Church traditionally honors Mary, the Mother of Jesus, our Lord and Savior. During this month, we also celebrate and remember our mothers.

Together let us pray "The Angelus" in appreciation for the gift of our mothers.

V: The angel of the Lord declared unto Mary,

R: And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary...

V: Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

R: Be it done unto me according to thy word.

Hail Mary ...

V: And the Word was made flesh.

R: And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary...

V: Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

R: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: Pour forth, we beseech thee, O Lord, thy grace into our hearts, that we to whom the incarnation of Christ thy Son was made known by the message of an angel, may by his passion and cross be brought to the glory of his resurrection, through the same Christ our Lord.
