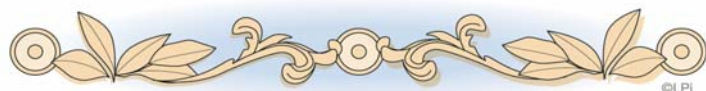

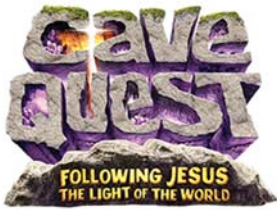

The Angelus

The Angelus is a devotional prayer commemorating the Incarnation. It is practiced by reciting, as verse and response, three Scripture verses narrating the mystery of the Incarnation and alternating with the Hail Mary.

Traditionally, this devotion was recited in churches, convents, and monasteries three times daily, at 6:00 AM, noon, and 6:00 PM. The Angelus is usually accompanied by the ringing of the Angelus bell which is a call to prayer and to spread good-will to everyone. The angel referred to in the prayer is Gabriel, a messenger of God, who revealed to Mary that she was to be the Mother of God.

During this month of May, the Church traditionally honors Mary, the Mother of Jesus, our Lord and Savior. During this month, we also celebrate and remember our mothers.

Together let us pray "The Angelus" in appreciation for the gift of our mothers.



Beginning next weekend, May 28th and 29th on the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Precious Blood will be offered at the 4 PM and 9 AM Masses. We ask that if you would like to receive from the cup that you sit towards the front of the church where ministers will be stationed during communion. As you approach the Minister of the Cup, bow as a sign of reverence. The Minister will say "The Blood of Christ" and you respond "Amen." Take the cup in your own hands; take a small sip of the Precious Blood and then slowly and carefully return the cup to the Minister. ..This physical act of Communion is always to be that of "receiving" as a sign of humility in accepting the Gift of the Eucharist.

R: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: Pour forth, we beseech thee, O Lord, thy grace into our hearts, that we to whom the incarnation of Christ thy Son was made known by the message of an angel, may by his passion and cross be brought to the glory of his resurrection, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

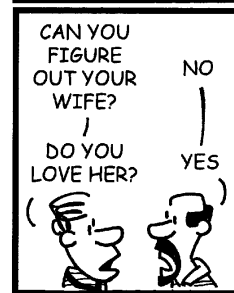
